Frequently Asked Questions:

What is a webinar? A webinar is a remote learning seminar. We meet online once a month for two hours, focusing each time on a different topic related to the treatment of trauma and dissociation from a neurobiological perspective. Each month, a few days prior to each live webinar, participants receive an email with access instructions and handouts relevant to the month's topic. Then, at the scheduled day and time, participants log on to the host website and use a password to enter the meeting. Participants from the US or Canada can access the audio portion of the webinar via a tollfree telephone number or streaming audio, while those from Europe, Africa, or Asia have access only to streaming audio. All participants can ask questions and present case material via an instant messaging system, allowing application of the theoretical material to real clinical situations.

When does it take place? The seminar is carefully timed to fit into most time zones. It meets one Monday per month from 12pm-2pm US Eastern Standard Time. (In the UK, the hours are 5-7pm; in Europe, from 6-8pm; on the West Coast, from 9-11am.) Go to www.timeanddate.com for the time of the webinar in your area.

What if I can't participate at the scheduled times? Each webinar is recorded and made available for viewing or reviewing online for those who might have a date or time conflict that month. Many participants prefer listening to the recordings. Others enjoy being a part of the live webinar but also reviewing it later online at their own pace. An mp3 download option is also available to participants at an additional cost of \$75.

Can I get CEUs or CPDs? In past years, this program has been co-sponsored by PESI and was approved for 20 CE hours for Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists, and Psychologists. Other disciplines should consult their state boards to determine whether any of these acceptable as evidence of continuing education credit. CEs for this coming year are currently pending. Registrants in the UK, Europe, and Canada can obtain a certificate documenting their credit hours at the end of the course, and Canadian therapists will also have a chance to obtain CEs through Jack Hirose Seminars.

How do I register? To register as an individual, go to www.janinafisher.com and click on Webinars and Seminars. At the bottom of the page, you will find links to PayPal, an online payment site where you may safely register and pay using a credit card or PayPal account using their secure system. Participants may pay in full or pay in either 4 or 10 regular installment payments.

How do group discounts help? A group registration simply involves 3 or more individuals who wish to register together. Each may participate as a group or individually, and there is no group obligation beyond the registrations. Full tuition is \$475 (\$425 early bird rate by August 15th). For a group of 3-5, the webinar cost is \$375 (\$95 or \$38 per session each). For a group of 6-9, the cost goes down to \$295 or \$30 per month or \$75 when paid in four installments. For a group of 10 or more, the cost is \$275 each, \$28 per session or 4 installments of \$70 each.
